Automobile Insurance Reform.....What to Expect

The Government announced potential changes in the Ontario Budget pertaining to the automobile insurance reform. Some of what we can expect include;

- Overhauling the licensing system for health service providers to reduce the regulatory burden and lower treatment fees paid by providers
- Standardized IME process
- Online claims process so consumers can see how their accident benefits are being utilized
- Increased choices to make policies more affordable such as lower premiums if consumers agree to use preferred providers of car repair and health care services
- Care Not Cash – default clause to ensure that auto insurance coverage will pay for treatment as opposed to legal fees with an option to receive cash settlements if selected
- Improved early treatment regime for minor injuries which will include treatment for Mental Health;
- A return to the default benefit limit of \$2 million for those catastrophically injured
